

ComiCon Writing contests:

Contests are open to anyone. Failure to adhere to any rule renders your entry subject to rejection. Use black type on a white page with 12 point Arial or Courier fonts. Set your margins to one inch and do not justify. Contestants may enter more than one contest simultaneously. Additionally, contestants may enter a single contest more than once. All entries must be submitted to Tina at the Clearwater Public Library by October 15, 2017.

All entries must have cover page with:

- Entry title
- Contest name
- Author First and Last name
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Email

Short Story: Entry consists of one short story totaling no more than 1,967 words (the year our Library joined the South Central Kansas Library Association), double –spaced. All forms of Sci-Fi/Fantasy genre are acceptable, including the following: Sci-Fi, Fantasy, Young Adult, Steampunk, Cyberpunk, Alternative History, Paranormal, Urban Fantasy, etc., or combination thereof.

Poetry: Entry consists of no more than three (3) typed poems totaling 100 lines or fewer. If more than one poem is entered, poems will be judged as a collection. There are no restrictions as far as style, content or spacing.

All entries will be included in a book we will create of the ComiCon. You will be able to preorder/prepay for a copy of the book.
